

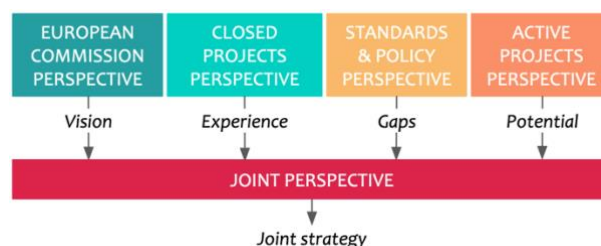
## ECSCI Remote Workshop (ECSCI SPM Workshop)

Tuesday, December 5th, 2023

Our goal is to gather different perspectives on the resilience of the Critical Infrastructure (CI) in Europe and form a joint strategy for efficient and effective collaborative standardisation and policy making.
